

FRUIT AND VEGETABLES

[On paper plates no bigger than 9"/ 23cm diameter]

1. 12 raspberries; stalks on
2. 3 eating apples, any one variety
3. A plate of any other fruit
4. 3 potatoes
5. 3 carrots
6. 3 onions, skin on
7. 6 beans, any variety/type [with stalk]
8. 2 sweetcorn
9. A lettuce with root still on.
10. 3 courgettes.
11. 1 cabbage [with 3" stalk]
12. 6 tomatoes [with stalks on]
13. 3 beetroots with tops on
14. A garlic bulb
15. 3 chilli peppers

The following don't need a plate.

16. A cucumber
17. The longest bean
18. The heaviest onion with 1" of stalk.
19. The heaviest marrow.
20. 3 dressed onions.
21. A squash/pumpkin, any variety
22. Box/Tray of 6 different vegetables.

FLOWERS

[Please keep the container simple]

23. A vase of herbs, 4 different kinds
24. A vase of sweet peas; 6 stems; 3 different colours
25. A vase of mixed herbaceous perennial garden flowers; 5 stems each different
26. A vase of mixed annuals; 5 stems, each different
27. 3 dahlias, each different
28. A vase of mixed roses, any type.

FLORAL ART

29. A flower arrangement using foraged materials.
30. A Japanese Ikebana flower arrangement.
 - Space allowed for the entry will be no more than 18" wide and 24" high
 - Foliage and flowers need not have been grown by the exhibitor
 - Entries should be constructed before bringing to the hall.

PHOTOGRAPHY

[Photographs should be no more than A4 / 30cm x 21 cm and simply mounted]

31. Pathways
32. Pairs
33. Abandoned buildings.

[Artwork no bigger than 60 x 60cm. Picture sizes excludes any mount]

34. Painting, any medium: 'Forgotten Corner'
35. Painting, any medium: Still Life 'Exotic Fruit'
36. A picture using material and /or thread; THEME 'Summer Fields'
37. A Picture Frame, any medium/material.
38. A mobile phone or tablet case in your choice of materials.
39. A vase of knitted or crochet flowers.
40. A poem: Theme of "Promises".

PRODUCE

[All jars to be approx. 400gms or 1lb]

41. 1 jar of jam of any fruit
42. 1 jar of lime curd.
43. 1 jar of fruit jelly
44. 1 jar of marmalade
45. 1 jar of chutney.
46. 6 Macarons, any flavour filled.
47. A lemon tart no bigger than 23cm/9"
48. 6 undecorated Chocolate Biscuits using flour, butter, sugar, cocoa/chocolate. Your recipe.
49. 6 Savoury Scones. Your recipe.
50. 3 individual Apple Strudels using bought Filo pastry.

51. A bottle of flavoured gin or brandy. Label with flavour.

52. A bottle of home- made wine labelled with type.

53. **St. Clements Drizzle Cake**; 175g caster sugar, 175g butter, grated zest and juice of a large lemon and a large orange, up to 4tsp. milk, 2 eggs, 175g self-raising flour, 3 tbsp. granulated sugar. Use a large loaf tin, bake at 180C/ Fan160C Gas 4 for about 45 mins. Use the juice of the lemon and orange for the drizzle with the granulated sugar.

54. Men Only. Coffee and Walnut Cake.

175g unsalted butter, 175g light brown sugar, 3 large eggs, 175g self-raising flour, 50ml strong coffee, 50g walnuts.
Buttercream Topping and Filling, 100g unsalted butter, 150g icing sugar, 50ml strong coffee, walnut halves to decorate. Use the creaming method for making the cake or the all-in-one method but add a flat tsp. of baking powder if you use this method. Use 2 round cake tins of approx. 18cm /7 to 8 ". Cook at 180C / Fan 160C Gas 4. For 20/25 mins.
