LETTER FROM MELVIN BENN, RE LEEDS FESTIVAL 2017 – August 2017

Dear Resident,

LEEDS FESTIVAL TRAFFIC PLAN

I wanted to write to tell you about the traffic routing for Leeds Festival 2017 and to highlight the road closures and routes that form part of the plan to you.

Please take a few minutes to look at these traffic arrangements, plan your route in advance and leave some extra time to reach your destination.

The key route for festival traffic from the A1 (M) / Grange Moor / Wattle Syke is south along West Woods Road, and then left over Thorner Road Bridge and south on Bramham by pass / Paradise Way to Paradise Bridge and this route will be used throughout. This traffic will be travelling one way in.

From 9pm Sunday 27th August, this route reverses as festival goers leave along the same route but in the opposite direction. This traffic will be travelling one way out and Monday morning will be another peak period.

The previous one way system on the A64 on the Thursday has been removed. There is a new one way system on the Sunday evening and Monday.

On Sunday 27th and Monday 28th August, the A64 between the Fox and Grapes public house and the A1(M) / A64 roundabout **will be closed to all traffic travelling eastbound** (i.e. from Leeds to York).

The one way system will run from 21:00pm on Sunday 27th till the Monday 28th August, we will take it off as earlier as possible.


Please also note the following additional road closures:

- The junction of Kiddal Lane and the A64 York Road
- The junction of Potterton Lane and Kiddal Lane

There are also temporary speed limits and clearway orders in the vicinity of the festival site. These will be clearly signposted.
