
Clifford Neighbourhood Plan Community Group OPEN DAY – 26th October 2013


The event displayed the work carried out towards the preparation of our Neighbourhood Plan, based on what you'd told us twelve months ago via the Household Survey questionnaire and our 2012 open day. Feedback from the latest open day was generally very supportive of the work undertaken so far, as well as for the policies we're developing for inclusion in the **Clifford Parish Neighbourhood Plan**. Visitors to the open day were invited to complete a short feedback form on the day – which included some specific "vote" style questions. Here are the results of these votes.

> The name for this new green space (to the side of St Edwards and behind the new-build St Edward's Wood).




The clear winner is St Edward's Wood.

The preferred option for the future of the existing village green (near the corner of Clifford Moor Rd and Bellwood Avenue).




The preferred option is to relocate the village green to a more central location in the parish. We are now investigation the feasibility of Leeds City Council releasing the area of the little used existing village green and using the proceeds to purchase land adjacent to the village hall / millennium park to develop as a new community green space. There are many hurdles to overcome, and it is by no means yet certain that this will be achievable.

Importance of Village Hall (on a scale of 1 = very important to 7 = not important).



The village hall is clearly highly valued – as we have seen via other evidence gathered over the last year.
