16/01 Crime Report

The PCSO reported that there had been 2 crimes in December.

16/02 Declarations of Interest & Notifications of changes in the Members' Register of Interest.

16/03 Public Participation Session

Residents reported that there was still parking on the pavement on Albion Street. Police have attended but it has not improved. Parking is obstructing access to property. It was suggested that bollards could be put on the pavement. The clerk to ask Leeds City Council Highways Department that consideration be given for bollards to be installed.

Outturn Forecast 2015/16

Income

The positive variance from budget is almost entirely due to the unbudgeted receipt of a donation of £2,977 from the Trustees of the Cricket Club and the expected receipt of an additional grant of £2,500 for the completion of the Neighbourhood Plan.

Expenditure

Expenditure is some £10,000 above budget. This is due to the unbudgeted cost of £10,542 to replace the flooring at the playground. The VAT element, £1,750, will be reclaimed in 2016/17 and some £7,000 has been taken from the earmarked fund. The forecast assumes that the Council will pay £1,200 for the Bramham School speed signs which have been installed.

Financial Position 31/03/2016

The Council will have a general reserve of £10,954 which is 52% of the Precept. This is towards the high end of the recommended range for general reserves.

Budget 2016/17

- Ensure that the open spaces for which the Council has responsibility are well maintained for use by residents. (£2,600 increase in budget for maintenance)

Report from the recent CAHA Committee meeting (6th Jan 2016):

- 1. Plot 1A (which used to be a car parking area before it was made into an Allotment, hence the unusual numbering) is currently vacant and there is some concern that it may not be possible to re-let it. The plot is heavily shaded to the east by trees which are now very tall and in one place branches actually overhang the plot, despite recent cutting-back by the owners. The previous tenant has moved to a sunnier plot. The trees have grown substantially during the occupancy of the previous tenant and there is now no direct sun on this plot until quite late in the morning.
- If would-be tenants decline this plot and it remains vacant, the possibilities currently under consideration for recommendation to Council are a: to return it to a car park, which would involve some outlay on hard core to make the surface firm again; or b: to use it as a store area for manure and/or gravel (for the lane) and/or road planings (for the lane).
- 2. The land drains in the centre track continue to work well. No allotments have been seen with standing water on the surface, although the water table is only an inch or so below the surface on many plots at the top of the hill; this is a significant improvement on a few years ago. However a spring continues to appear on Plot 8, and the ensuing 'river' runs down the hill through plots 6, 4 and 2. Consideration is being given to how this can be alleviated perhaps by piping the spring to the drain in the centre track, or by channelling it off Plot 8 onto adjacent land.
- 3. CAHA Accounts for the 2015 have been prepared and seen by the committee, and will be submitted to the Clerk for approval soon.
- 4. CAHA has produced a Draft Budget for the 2016/17 year, to assist with parish council budgetting. Members have that document in their packs for this meeting and I am able to answer questions.

- 5. The Association is collecting rents on behalf of the parish council. These are being paid into the CAHA bank account and will be transferred to the parish council account at at time to be agreed with the Responsible Financial Officer. At the moment the inflow of rents is approximately the same as would be expected from previous years' experience.
- 6. Following from 5 above, I believe that the amount of time that the clerk now spends on Allotments administration is substantially reduced and councillors may wish to consider reducing the proportion taken from the rental income to pay for the clerk's time. Our clerk will no doubt be able to guide on this matter.
