Public Transport Provision

Status as at 31 March 2020

Rail

A reduced service mostly hourly on all routes
Currently carrying 10% of normal weekday passengers

Bus

A reduced service mostly hourly on Key Worker Bus Network
A limited school bus service is in operation to the sites in operation.
Currently carrying 15% of normal weekday passengers

Key Worker Bus Network

This is broadly the core bus routes which is enabling key workers who habitually used public transport to get to work. The services may be adapted to meet key worker journey to work patterns during the emergency by reference to the Combined Authority in the first instance.

Serving new Key Worker Travel Needs (Nightingale Hospital etc) – the Combined Authority is able to co-ordinate the provision of additional bus transport.
